



## Installing the projects Java software onto your Nokia via a USB cable

The following items are needed to install the software via USB cable:

- USB connection Cable for your phone
- Nokia PC Suite installed (download at <http://europe.nokia.com/A41157164>)

### Installation Process

1. Download the “**SAY.zip**” file from this link (<http://www.soundaroundyou.com/Downloads/SAY.zip>) if you haven’t already done so. When downloaded, unzip the two files to an easy to find place on your PC, eg: the Desktop.
2. Making sure Nokia PC Suite is running; connect your phone to the computer using your USB cable.
3. Your phone will be showing a number of options on its screen. Please click on the “PC Suite/Mode” option and wait for the computer to connect to your phone.
4. Browse to the location where you unzipped the “**SAY.jad**” and “**SAY.jar**” files on your PC and right click on “**SAY.jar**”.
5. Select “**Install With Nokia Application Installer**” to begin the installation of Sound Around You J2ME. You may need to confirm the install on your PC and on your phone when prompted (we recommend you choose the option to install on “**Phone Memory**” if prompted to do so).
6. When installation is complete, disconnect the phone from the USB cable.
7. Please go through the steps in the section “**Enabling Access Permissions**” after the application has installed.
8. Once installed and setup you can launch the application from the “**Applications**” option in the Main Menu (**make sure your phone is not set to “silent”**).

## Enabling Access Permissions

After you have installed Sound Around You J2ME you need to enable the access permissions to enable Sound Around You J2ME to access the phone's file system and recording functions.

Your Nokia phone will either be a series 60 or series 40 model. The larger and more recent models are generally series 60.

### Nokia Series 60 phones:

Go to **Tools >> Manager >> Sound Around You J2ME >> Options >> Suite settings**

If the above route is not present:

Go to **Applications >> App. Mgr. >> Sound Around You J2ME > Open**

If the above route is not present:

Go to **Settings >> Data mgr. >> App. mgr. >> Sound Around You J2ME >> Open**

Select **Read User Data** and set the access permissions to **Never Ask/Always allowed**.

Select **Write/Edit User Data** and set the access permissions to **Never Ask/Always allowed**.

Select **Multimedia** and set the access permissions to **Never Ask/Always allowed**.

If you don't have the option to set these to Never Ask/Always allowed, then you most likely installed the Sound Around You J2ME as an unsigned application (using the Sound Around You J2ME.jar file directly), or you don't have the Thawte root certificate on your phone.

### Nokia Series 40 phones:

Go to **Sound Around You J2ME** (browse through applications folder) >> **Options >> Application access >> Phone access/Data access**

Select **Read User Data** and set the access permissions to **Never Ask/Always allowed**.

Select **Add and edit data** and set the access permissions to **Never Ask/Always allowed**.

Select **Multimedia Recording** and set the access permissions to **Never Ask/Always allowed**.

(some series 40 phones may still show a denied message in error when beginning recording but this will not affect your recording)

If you don't have the option to set these to Never Ask, then you most likely installed the Sound Around You J2ME as an unsigned application (using the Sound Around You J2ME jar file directly), or you don't have the Thawte root certificate on your phone
