



Installing the project's Java software from your Nokia phone's internet browser

This method of installing the project software onto your mobile phone uses the device browser and internet connection to navigate to the provided address. The download will start automatically.

Your mobile operator may charge you for the download of the software; however the Sound Around You Project will not make any charges. If you are not happy with any charges being made by your mobile operator then try the alternative install methods at:

Installation Process

Information and help on each stage of the installation can be found in the numbered links (x), shown at the end.

1. Open up your phone's internet browser and enter the following address:

<http://www.soundaroundyou.com/say> (1)

2. Then click on the link shown "[Download Sound Around You J2ME](#)".

3. Your phone will ask you if you would like to download: "Sound Around You J2ME". Once you have confirmed this, the download will begin (**do not start the application yet if offered to do so**).

4. Please go through the steps in the section "**Enabling Access Permissions**" after the application has installed.

5. Once the software has been successfully downloaded, installed and setup, it can be launched on the device. The application launcher location will be in Applications on the main menu, where you can scroll to the Sound Around You J2ME launcher and select open (**make sure your phone is not set to "silent"**).

Enabling Access Permissions

After you have installed Sound Around You J2ME you need to enable the access permissions to enable Sound Around You J2ME to access the phone's file system and recording functions.

Your Nokia phone will either be a series 60 or series 40 model. The larger and more recent models are generally series 60.

Nokia Series 60 phones:

Go to **Tools >> Manager >> Sound Around You J2ME >> Options >> Suite settings**

If the above route is not present:

Go to **Applications >> App. Mgr. >> Sound Around You J2ME > Open**

If the above route is not present:

Go to **Settings >> Data mgr. >> App. mgr. >> Sound Around You J2ME >> Open**

Select **Read User Data** and set the access permissions to **Never Ask/Always allowed**.

Select **Write/Edit User Data** and set the access permissions to **Never Ask/Always allowed**.

Select **Multimedia** and set the access permissions to **Never Ask/Always allowed**.

If you don't have the option to set these to Never Ask/Always allowed, then you most likely installed the Sound Around You J2ME as an unsigned application (using the Sound Around You J2ME.jar file directly), or you don't have the Thawte root certificate on your phone.

Nokia Series 40 phones:

Go to **Sound Around You J2ME** (browse through applications folder) >> **Options >> Application access >> Phone access/Data access**

Select **Read User Data** and set the access permissions to **Never Ask/Always allowed**.

Select **Add and edit data** and set the access permissions to **Never Ask/Always allowed**.

Select **Multimedia Recording** and set the access permissions to **Never Ask/Always allowed**.

(some series 40 phones may still show a denied message in error when beginning recording but this will not affect the recording)

If you don't have the option to set these to Never Ask, then you most likely installed the Sound Around You J2ME as an unsigned application (using the Sound Around You J2ME jar file directly), or you don't have the Thawte root certificate on your phone
